

MailWarden Pro Upgrade

Upgrade Procedure from MailWarden DE or MailWarden Pro 6.0 to MailWarden Pro 6.0.5

1. Ensure that you have a full system backup that includes all MailWarden Registry keys and installation directory.
2. Download the MailWarden Pro upgrade utility from the Seattle Lab website by following this link: <http://www.seattlelab.com/products/mailwardenpro/utilities.asp>
3. Stop the MailWarden Services. You can do this through the MailWarden Control Panel. Locate the Service Control sub-frame on the System Tab and hit the Stop button.
4. Once the services have stopped, close the MailWarden Control Panel.
5. Extract the MailWarden Pro upgrade utility (*mwupgrade.exe*) from the downloaded zip file onto your hard drive.
6. Ensure that your TEMP environment variable is pointing to a valid directory.
7. Open a command prompt and change to the directory that you unzipped the upgrade files to.
8. Perform a backup of Mail Warden user/application configuration data by running the following command:

```
mwupgrade /backup
```

This will store important application and user configuration data to \$TEMP/mwbin/ on your hard drive.

9. Click on Control Panel / Add/Remove Programs. Select MailWarden and click the remove button.
10. Restart your computer after the uninstall if you are on NT4.0.
11. Install MailWarden Pro. For information on installing MailWarden Pro please refer to the Installation Guide. If prompted to reboot your computer select Yes. The MailWarden Pro Installation Guide is available on our website at <http://www.seattlelab.com/products/mailwardenpro/docs.asp>
12. Install Virus Control. To do this, select the MailWarden Pro configuration control panel:
 - a. Go to Start -> Programs -> MailWarden Pro -> MailWarden Pro Configuration.
 - b. Select the Virus Control Tab. There will be an option to Install Virus Control.
 - c. Select this to install the virus control. Once the installation has finished, close the MailWarden Pro Configuration.
13. Once your computer has restarted, open a command prompt and change to the directory that you unzipped the upgrade files to.
14. Perform a restore of user/application configuration data by running the following command:

```
mwupgrade /restore
```

This will restore important application and user configuration data to the MailWarden Pro configuration database.

Note: If you are upgrading from MailWarden Pro 6.0.4 to 6.0.5 you do Not need to follow step 15 and can proceed directly to step 16.

15. Import the GSC Rule. To do this
 - a. Download the GSC.ini file from our website at <http://www.seattlelab.com/products/mailwardenpro/utilities.asp>. Save this file to the install directory for Mail Warden Pro. The default location is C:\Program Files\Mail Warden Pro
 - b. Go to Start -> Programs -> MailWarden Pro -> MailWarden Pro Configuration.
 - c. Select the Rules Tab. At the bottom of the configuration, there is an option to Import.
 - d. Select Import. A browse window will come up. Browse to the GSC.ini file that was just downloaded and select Open. This will create the GSC rule.

16. Register a Mail Warden 6.0 Professional License by following the procedure outlined in the MailWarden Pro Installation Guide.
